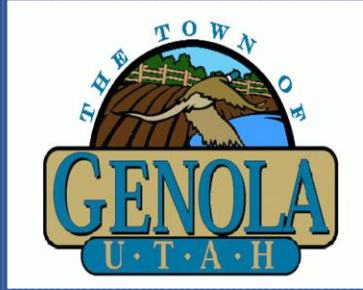

POLICE CHIEF'S MESSAGE

Residential Security Tips:

- 1- Notify a trusted neighbor you will be out of town. Please let them know when you will be departing and when you will return.
- 2- Purchase an inexpensive timer to turn lights off and on. Do your best to make it appear someone is home.
- 3- Use a wood dowel or piece of lumber to secure basement windows.
- 4- Do not unnecessarily advertise your absence to anyone who does not need to know.
- 5- Report any "doorbell ditching" immediately 801.794.3970.
- 6- If something seems odd, out of place, out of character, or just plain strange, please report it immediately: 801.794.3970 or 911.
- 7- Physical descriptions of the vehicle/person and license plate numbers are invaluable.
- 8- If residents are going to be absent for an extended period of time, contact the police department for an extra patrol.

If people are not comfortable calling the police department we have an application called "MyPd", wherein it can be downloaded to any wireless device. Tips or information can be submitted (with pictures). "MyPd" can also be accessed from any personal computer. Informants can leave their name or be totally anonymous. Local Veterinarian will provide rabies shots for \$12 and other vaccinations for \$10-\$20. Animal Licenses - \$15 for altered (spayed or neutered) and \$35 for unaltered.

***The town of Genola requires all dogs to be licensed. Anyone with 3 or more dogs is required to have a kennel license. Licenses can be purchased at the Genola Town Office.**
