## **GENOLA FIRE DEPARTMENT**

We would like to remind those that burn fires in their home to safely dispose of fire place ashes.

Always place ashes in an ash bucket made of non-flammable material such as metal or earthenware. Do not store your ash bucket on or around anything combustible and if they are still smoldering ashes pour a little water over them. Let ashes sit for at least three days before disposing of them, never put warm or hot ashes in the household garbage cans for pickup. Also please keep the snow removed around the fire hydrants by your home, this will help us find them if needed. Reminder of open burn dates they are March 30<sup>th</sup> and run through May 30<sup>th</sup>, to obtain an open burn permit log onto [deq.utah.gov](http://deq.utah.gov) and look for permits.

EXAMPLE: if (name, business) sponsored 1 dozen eggs, then someone from (name, business) would come to the park with 12 treats/ prizes (stickers, toothbrush, small toy, chocolate bunny, etc) and wait for kids to come collect. The child would look at their egg see it said (name, business) and would look for (name, business) at a designated area. Once the child finds where (name, business) is they will take their egg to (name, business) and show them the egg and collect the treat/ prize.
