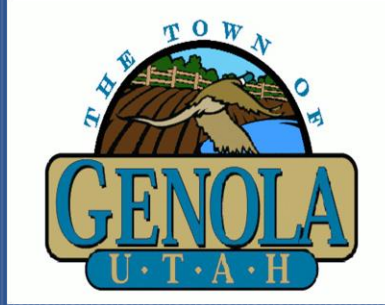

Senior Citizens will resume on September 11<sup>th</sup> @ 11:00 am.

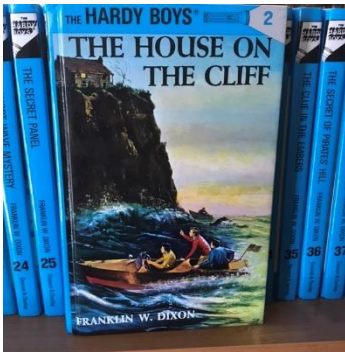
