FALCON "2022"

- Games are 6 innings or time limits. No new inning will begin after 55 minutes. Time determined by time at third out. If the time is 54 minutes when the third out occurs, a new inning should start.
- **Falcon league games will play a six run offensive limit ALL INNINGS. The play where the sixth run is scored is live and all runs will be counted until the play is complete (by getting ball to pitcher or a third out). If home team is down more than 9 runs in the last inning they will not be able to win the game.**
- **RUNNERS THAT REMAIN ON BASE WILL NOT BE ON BASE TO START NEXT INNING!!**
- **GAMES THAT ARE TIED AFTER 6 INNINGS OR 55 MIN WILL END IN A TIE, AS LONG AS HOME TEAM HAS COMPLETED THEIR LAST BAT.**
- Umpires should announce official game time to both teams.
- Games start at scheduled time **NO** grace period unless field is not ready.
- Games rained out will not be made up, unless absolutely necessary Four (4) complete innings will be called a game.
- Home team is team listed first on the schedule. They are to provide the game balls.
- **ALL PLAYERS SHOULD BE IN FULL UNIFORM.**
- Ten (10) players will be used in the field.
- Seven (7) players must be present to field a legal team. If only seven players are present an automatic out will be charged after the 7th player bats. **NO AUTOMATIC OUTS WILL BE CHARGED IF 8 OR MORE PLAYERS ARE PLAYING.**
- All players should play at least $\frac{1}{2}$ of each official game and/or scheduled game time.
- If a team is leading its opponent by at least 8 runs after 4 or more equal innings have been played, or after 3 1/2 innings if the home team has an 8 run lead at the end of its third inning, the game shall be terminated and the team in the lead declared the winner.
- **ALL PLAYERS WILL BE PUT IN THE BATTING ORDER AND BAT EACH TIME THEIR TURN COMES AROUND.**
- There will be **STEALING** of bases. Players will be allowed to leave occupied base once ball has crossed home plate.
- Catcher is required to wear chest protector, facemask, throat protection, and shin guards at all times while they are on the field.
- All play will stop when the pitcher is standing inside the pitcher circle and the ball enters or passes through the circle-regardless of whether the pitcher catches the ball or not. Base runners must go to the nearest base.
- Helmets **MUST** be worn by the batter, the on-deck batter, and by all base runners. Helmets must remain on the head until the person reaches the dugout. An out will be called if the helmet is removed at any time before the player returns to the dugout.
- Infield fly rule **does not** apply.
- Dropped third strike rule **does not** apply.
- Slide rule. A runner is out when they do not legally slide or attempt to get around a player who has the ball and is ready to make the tag. This is NOT a "must slide rule." Any player who does not attempt to get around the player and causes malicious contact will be ejected from the game. Umpires discretion on attempt and malicious. Any fielder that blocks the base path without possession of the ball will be called with obstruction.
- **Taunting Rule** – No taunting, or shouting, by players, coaches, catchers, or spectators at opposing players or coaches (this includes swing after "hey batter, batter"). All cheering, shouting, and chattering must be directed at players on your own team. Catchers must remain quiet at all time while catching. Warning by umpire or director, then removal from the game and/or playing field as deemed necessary by the officials.
- Umpires for the **Falcon League** are **STRONGLY** encouraged to **EXPAND** their strike zone to include all pitches that a batter can reach (shoulders to mid shin & anything close on the edges of the plate). **ESPECIALLY**, when it is evident that the batter is looking to walk and is not going to swing the bat. Coaches are **STRONGLY DISCOURAGED** to have batters take pitches.
- Umpires are responsible to keep the game moving. Encourage teams to hurry on and off the field. Keep warm-up pitches to a minimum. Coaches please be aware of this and do your part to get a full game in.
